First Question that every DLM/Club Captain should ask themselves is: How do I designate a 'lowest class' to any player on my substitutes list?

If this player was available for league and was selected on a team, which team would that be? The class in which this team is playing should correspond to the 'lowest class' designation assigned to this player. In other words, the 'lowest class' designation is determined relative to the standard of the players nominated on teams.

It is NOT the class/teams that the DLM/Club Captain would like to make this player eligible/available to sub for.
